General Information and Instructions for Budget Add-Ons

In determining the cost of attendance (COA), National University uses the budget established by the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC). This standard budget is used to determine financial need for all students who apply for aid. You may be able to increase your budget and your financial aid eligibility if you incur expenses during the academic year that are higher than the standard financial aid budget. This is called a Budget Add On.

Expenses that may be considered for a Budget Add On include:

- Books and supplies
- Child Care
- Computer (1 increase every three years)
- Medical/Dental/Optical/Insurance
- Rent and Utilities
- Transportation

Instructions:

Submit a student statement detailing the reason for the increase.

Submit a budget detailing the expenses beyond the standard budget

Submit documentation supporting the increase. Documentation needs to be in the form of receipts, billing statements, lease or rental agreement etc.
